## Acupuncturist heads for Gaza

A KINGSWOOD acupuncturist is hoping to treat those stricken in one of the most dangerous places in the world next month.

Gisela Norman will help run a clinic in the Gaza Strip in the Palestinian territories, which will provide acupuncture and osteopathy to civilians and refugees.

Normally Ms Norman treats patients at the Kingswood Natural Health Centre on Two Mile Hill Road, but she will head to Palestine as part of a project organised by World Medicine, a charity which provides alternative healthcare to people suffering from the consequences of war, natural disaster and poverty.

The charity was set up following the 2004 Boxing Day tsunami.

Ms Norman said: "This will be probably the most fulfilling work I will ever do. We would greatly appreciate donations to enable us to do this."
